Executive Director's Report:

- Award of Hot Water Boiler Replacement Bid at 550 Building After the initial bids were rejected, several of the same contractors submitted for the re-bid, some contractors were new. The lowest qualified bidder was William J. Guarini, Inc.
- <u>CDBG 2022 Grant Award Contract (Senior Activity Center)</u> The Cliffside Park Housing Authority has been awarded a contract for grant, in the amount of \$45,000, for the salary of a Nutrition Coordinator in the Senior Activity Center for Grant Cycle 2022-2023.

<u>Buildings and Grounds Committee</u> – Two apartments have been turned over for November. The repointing and waterproofing project is making progress. There have been issues with the PAL roof project, as the consistency in the worker's presence, as well as the quality of the work are questionable. Mr. Capano noted that the contractors have been put on notice.

Personnel Committee – No report.

Activity Center Report – The October 31st Halloween Dance was a great success, with great costumes, and a visit from Mayor Calabrese. The upcoming month of November is busy with trips, workshops and events. Yesterday, the Senior Activity Center hosted a very successful Horse Race. Throughout November, there are several health, healing and AARP workshops scheduled. The Activity Center has added a new Zumba Class and a second Exercise Class to the Class Roster. There is a trip to the Yogi Berra Museum, as well as luncheon trips on the calendar, as well. The Veterans' Honoring will be happening on Monday, November 14.

Old Business – The Housing Choice Voucher (Section 8) Waiting List was open from October 17, 2022 through October 31, 2022. The Cliffside Park Housing Authority collected completed applications through November 4, 2022. We are now going through the screening process, determining applicants' eligibility. Once vouchers are ready to be distributed, we will host a "Housing Choice Voucher Course" where several applicants will receive their vouchers, as well as learn about the program. Mr. Capano also indicated that protocols for HQS Inspections have changed, and courses with updated information will be scheduled.
