Chairman's Report - Chairman Colao had no formal report.

<u>Finance Committee</u> – Bill Katchen, CPA, has been in the office closing out the books, FYE 3/31/2023. Executive Director, Joseph Capano, thanked Mr. Katchen for his work. Chairman Colao inquired about the Section 8 finances and account, asking Bill Katchen if some of the administrative funds can be used to open a CD. Mr. Katchen advised that it could be. An analysis is going to be made; the Executive Director, Chairman, and Financial Team will decide if the Cliffside Park Housing Authority will open a CD with a portion of the administrative funds.

<u>Buildings and Grounds Committee</u> – Apartments are being turned over for July and August occupancy. The parking lot at 215 Riverview Avenue Apartments has been assessed, and parking has now been assigned. The Cliffside Park Housing Authority is currently looking for an individual to monitor the premises. We are still working with LAN Associates and Silva Mechanic to rectify mixing valve issues in the 500 Building; most of the valves have been replaced.

<u>Personnel Committee</u> – Summer help has been in the office and has been successfully purging files.

Activity Center Report – Linda Phillips-Perez, Activity Center Coordinator, reported that the summer trips have all been successful. The shore trips have been splitting between Long Branch and Point Pleasant. The casino trips have been full, and the Activity Center is considering booking two buses for Atlantic City's trip. Due to the rain during the Farmers' Market, our seniors were bussed to other markets, so they were able to utilize their voucher, thanks to our Activity Center Staff's quick thinking. Mr. Capano noted that at the Activity Center Advisory Board Meeting, the Summer Barbecue and Holiday Parties were discussed.

<u>Professionals' Reports</u> – Frank Borin is working through the changes for the JIF Employee Handbook, which, when completed, we will update our personnel policy.
